On **March 25th, 2020** the commissioner's office issued the document "Updated Guidance on Driver and Traffic Safety Education in Response to COVID-19". An additional follow up was issued on **April 20th, 2020** attempting to clarify that programs could complete their hours during the summer or fall of 2020.



Since April, circumstances have changed. **August 26th, 2020** New York State has issued further guidance for the fall semester and thereafter depending on the COVID situation.

We will be further discussing ways for NYSDTSEA to assist members moving forward under the new guidelines.

Our next conference in 2021 is still scheduled and we have not made any decision to go virtual as of now. A lot can happen in 7 months so we will keep you informed.

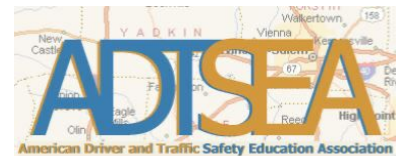
